WOMEN IN MINISTRY

It is easy to identify ways in which women have blessed our lives. The Bible has many examples of women who served as a . . . leader <u>Deborah</u>, teacher <u>Priscilla</u>, deacon <u>Phoebe</u>, MVP <u>Proverbs 31 woman</u>, and prophet <u>Philips four daughters</u>.

Luke 8:1-3

Luke's summary of Jesus' team is unique in that day. Three women are mentioned specifically from the broken life of <u>Mary Magdalene</u>, to the notoriety of <u>JoAnn</u>. Jesus affirmed the <u>contribution</u> and <u>significance</u> of women.

Difficult Passages . . .

- The Church in Corinth
 - √ Women <u>praying</u> and <u>prophesying</u> (1 Corinthians 11:5-6)
 - ✓ Women should remain silent (1 Corinthians 14:34-35)
- Disorder in the Church (14:33)
 - ✓ tongues (14:27-28 ✓ prophets (14:29-31) ✓ women (14:34-35)
- The Ministry of Timothy (1 Timothy 2:9-15)
 - ✓ There was a need for modesty & maturity.
 - √ Women should <u>learn</u>
 - ✓ At this time, I do not <u>permit</u> women . . .

Creational Pattern points to headship (Ephesians 5:23)

- √ The Early Church appointed <u>overseers</u> (men—1 Timothy 3:1-7)
- ✓ Deacons served as <u>leaders</u> (women & men—I Timothy 3:8-11)

The umbrella of <u>authority</u> in the church frees women and men to serve in the church consistent with their maturity, gifts, knowledge, experience and character.
