THE TIPPING POINT

There is a critical point in our story that tips the scales in such a way that the situation will never be the same. We have arrived at this juncture, when the most repeated question is finally answered: Who is this?

Luke 9:10-20

There are two miracles mentioned in all four Gospel accounts (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John). This amazing miracle and the <u>resurrection</u>. 5,000 men equals around <u>20,000</u> people. Jesus invites his disciples to rest after they have been on mission, sent out by Jesus. But the <u>crowd</u> follows him.

- * Jesus <u>provides</u> = Jehovah <u>Jireh</u>
- * The disciples are <u>annoyed</u> and <u>overwhelmed</u> Jesus is <u>welcoming</u> and <u>compassionate</u>
- * Jesus gives thanks for 5 loaves and 2 fish (John 6:9)
- * 12 baskets were left over remember this
- * You are the Christ

Communion = take and eat

- 2) Did Jesus do this miracle for the crowd or for the disciples? Why?
- 3) How is the Lord the provider? What does that mean to you?
- 4) Why is Peter's statement so significant? Who is Jesus? Elaborate! What does that mean to you?
