# No IFS, ANDS, OR BUTS

Everything is set in motion when Peter declares that truth about Jesus (9:20). The disciples and others thought the glamour would lead to greatness for him and for them. But Christ's message takes an unexpected turn.

## The Beginning—Luke 9:21-27

\* No Ifs = <u>certainty</u> The Son of Man <u>must</u> . . . (v.22)

Like Jesus, we surrender (deny), sacrifice (take up),

and in step (follow) (v.23)

We believe yesterday, we decide today and we commit forever.

#### The Middle—Luke 9:43-50

No Ands = <u>Greatness</u> The <u>least</u> is the greatest. (v.48)
Listen, the Son of Man is going to be <u>delivered</u>
Greatness is not gracious; it is small and serving. (22:26)

### The End—Luke 9:51-62

\* No Buts = <u>First</u> I will <u>follow</u> you, Lord <u>but</u> . . . Jesus

shows us how to proceed; with resolve (v.51)

The cost of following Jesus . . .

Verse 58 — It is <u>hard</u> not <u>glamorous</u>

Verse 60 — More important than . . .

Verse 62 — No <u>turning</u> back

Is it worth the cost?!
