A passage of scripture that has been dominating my thoughts lately talks about the temple being "A house of prayer for all nations..."

The Lord Jesus was incensed with the Jewish leadership of His day to the point of driving the money changers and those selling the sacrificial animals, out of the Temple because they had neglected the prayer for the nations....

"When they arrived back in Jerusalem, Jesus entered the Temple and began to drive out the people buying and selling animals for sacrifices. He knocked over the tables of the money changers and the chairs of those selling doves, [16] and he stopped everyone from using the Temple as a marketplace. [17] He said to them, "The Scriptures declare, 'My Temple will be called a house of prayer for all nations,' but you have turned it into a den of thieves.""

Mark 11:15-17 NLT from Isaiah 56:7

With His actions, Jesus gave us an example of how important He considered prayer for the nations to be.

Now New Harvest has good reputation for being a praying church. There are any number of prayer groups that people can participate.

In the book 'Rethinking Global Mobilization', Ryan Shaw makes the statement...

Do you realize how often the verb "sent" is used in the Bible? The word is used



over 500 times. I realize that not every reference has to do with mission but the idea of being sent is especially strong in God's Word. Obviously, we get the word commission from sent. Sent and missions go hand in hand. The verb defines so much about our Christian life. I am called to live a "sent" life. Sent represents a primary message from God about us. Jesus said it both simply and profoundly in John 20:21. "Again Jesus said, 'Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.' And with that he breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'"

Report from the field...

A man who just believed told us his experience. Before he believed, he had a dream about believing in Jesus the Messiah. For several years after he had the dream, he tried to find out about Jesus. He had not gotten what he wanted, but he hoped that one day he would meet someone who would explain about Jesus to him. When our team met him and preached the Gospel to him, he finally confessed his belief in Jesus and was baptized and discipled. He is very spiritually thirsty and continues to meet with our team. He has reached five people in his family network.

Brunei

For the last 12 years I've been full time with YWAM in Salem, Oregon and have invested in many areas of ministry. I began working with our ropes challenge course where we would host churches, businesses and schools for a day of team building. In that time, we taught about godly character and how to have unity with one another in teams. From there I worked with three DTS schools and led two outreaches to Thailand where 19 people accepted Christ! Most recently I have gotten additional training through a Foundations for Counseling Ministries (FCM) school and Addictive Behavior Counseling (ABC) school. With this equipping I have been to Brazil for three outreaches where we have taught seminars and met with individuals to bring healing and

transformation through the love of Jesus and prayer. It was this last outreach from June to August 2023 that I felt God called me to move full time to Brazil.

My vision is to help others experience the healing love of Jesus that restores their identity.

I'm joining a YWAM ministry called Casa Rocha (Rock House), which is located in a slum area of Belo Horizonte. Casa Rocha is a community center focused on impacting individuals and families through community development and the love of God. The community center is a safe place in the local neighborhood for evangelism, Bible studies, kid's clubs, sports, water aerobics, workshops, house visits and more. I'm excited to join this amazing ministry and see how God will use my efforts, skills and experience to bring His Kingdom to this place.

Marie will be leaving for Brazil in September. We will have a commissioning service on September 1.

I will have a sign up to form a prayer team specifically for Marie as she faces this new adventure! Look for me in the hallway outside the auditorium to sign up. -- John
