


New Harvest Institute Instructor: Pastor Barry Braun

A big hello from Brazil!

I've been in Brazil for just over 3 weeks now and I feel



the shock is starting to subside and I no longer suffer from jet lag.

My language learning is going slow

and steady. I have a class twice a week and get lots of practice with pretty much anyone I meet. My language

class also has some Brazilian women who are learning to read and write. We do this class as a ministry to help people in the community thrive with the gift of literacy. It's cool to be in a class where I'm learning alongside others who didn't get the chance to learn these things when they were growing up.

My main prayer requests at this time are:

For a 5 day camp for the homeless on October
 9th - 13th. For the individuals to have encounters with God and wisdom and safety during that time.

In the closing summary of the article he makes the statement that **the basis of Mission is to reveal the Glory of God so that all mankind will worship Him!**

Borthwick quotes A.W. Tozer, a great leader and writer of the Christian and Missionary Alliance, who was fully committed to a missions vision, but feared that through our efforts to exhort action in missions we would diminish the worship of the Almighty. Tozer wrote, "We commonly represent God as a busy, eager, somewhat frustrated Father hurrying about seeking help to carry out His benevolent plan to bring peace and salvation to the world...Too many missionary appeals are based upon this fancied frustration of Almighty God." Borthwick goes on to say that Tozer is saying, in effect, "Don't get interested in missions out of some delusion that God is in trouble. He is still the Creator of the ends of the earth, the great Redeemer, the Almighty."

So, what is our concept of God and why we are involved in this endeavor we call "Missions" or "Global Outreach"? Are we trying to bail out our harried and hurried heavenly Father? Or are we resting in the fact that He has everything in His control and we are there to help as He calls on us? To God Be The Glory...Great Things He Has Done and Is Doing! Amen and Amen!
