## Amani Fellowship

### Highlights from Kenya

Amani Fellowship Mentors held a meeting on April 28th, and we look forward to the planned mentor outreach set for June 20th throughout Shinyalu village area. This program not only provides essential supplies and a physical check-in on our students during the mid-term but it also builds encouragement and relationships with these orphans which our monetary funds alone cannot provide. Five of our current Mentors will be visiting several students during the parent visitation days. This replaces the awkward and sad days of the past when these orphans had no one visit on this special parent day while other students rejoiced in joy of their parents visiting and bringing special homemade foods to remind them of home. Our students now also have a special surprise on this day set apart for them. Praise God for the continued development and provision for this program.

Augustine (Kenya AF Secretary) provided a recent update on the widow project specifically the results of the numerous seeds we provided to widows during our last missions trip in March. The plants are growing and are numerous! These women may be elderly, but they are strong farmers from youth and so very grateful for the vegetables which will soon provide a meal to their table but also the ability to sell or exchange produce for other items of need. What a joy to see what God does with such a simple provision of seeds for our widows!

# Report from Brazil

Ministry is rolling along here in Brazil and picking up steam! I'm pretty busy now with teaching, team building activities and going out into the community for evangelism and visits with families in the community. (Pictured: teaching the discipleship students)

I'm learning Portuguese rapidly now and am able to communicate pretty well. I still need translation for official teaching, but I'm good with normal day to day conversations. It's definitely encouraging to understand more of what is going on and to contribute in a greater way with ministry.

We've recently had a bit of a leadership change at the Light House (the community center where I do ministry). We are now a team of 3; with a small team, we each have multiple responsibilities. I've taken on the accounting role which is a bit difficult and different in another culture and in Portuguese. I'm managing ok, but it's an added challenge.

I want to thank New Harvest for contributing financially to the ministry here in Brazil. We've been able to help three Brazilian staff members with their passages to Rio Grande do Sul (southern Brazil) and Argentina for ministry. Thank you for investing in the financial support of Brazilian missionaries!

1. There is a contact named H\* and his wife who have heard the gospel and are often taught the word of God. But until now they have not wanted to believe because their family is all Muslim.

They are now about to get a divorce because H\* likes online gambling. So his wife is disappointed and she had an affair with another man. We continue to serve them so that they do not commit this sin and teach the principles of Christian marriage that do not allow divorce.

Today we have also visited them at their parents' house which is far from the city. H\* was also there to talk about his wife with his parents. At his parents' house we had time to preach the gospel to his mother, but she did not want to believe. H\* and his wife also listened. At that house we invited them to ask the Lord Jesus to come into their family by believing in Him.

Pray that God will help H\* and his wife so that they believe in the name of Jesus and their lives will change.

2. Pray for Mrs. Y\*, their parent who is open to the gospel but does not want to believe. At the end of the conversation we told the mother to keep remembering the name of Jesus and to ask for help from Him.
3. Pray for the village of P\* where they live, where there are no Christians. So that God will visit that place.
4. Pray for Believers: R\*, Y\*, E\*, Z\* so that they can return to follow up and be disciplined because they are busy working.
