Caleb's team - Prays for the House Church to be faithful in worship, grow in faith and continue to witness to their friends and family and live in the fear of God.

Nehemiah Team - Pray for the new HC in the C* area so that they continue to grow in faith.

On that day, we conducted a joint service to check eye-glasses in Parung Ponteng District. We visited Pak Rizal, one the residents we had previously served, but he still hadn't believed. The weather was unpredictable, with rain coming and going every hour. At that time, we met Pak Nasirin, a friend of Pak Rizal's, who was looking for grass to feed his sheep. Fortunately, Pak Nasirin was willing to have his eyes checked. One of the requirements to get glasses was to show an ID card, but Pak Nasirin didn't have it with him. We accompanied him to his house and helped carry the grass on our motorcycle despite the drizzle. When we arrived at Pak Nasirin's house, we met the Head of the Hamlet (Pak Kadus) who was escorting a friend looking for land to buy. After chatting, Pak Kadus also wanted to get reading glasses and asked us to survey a location for a Reading Post. Pak Nasirin's neighbors also asked for glasses.

After finishing the eye checks, the rain hadn't stopped yet. We chatted with Pak Nasirin's wife and shared the Gospel with her. When she heard that Jesus was able to heal the sick and even raise the dead, she told us about her youngest child, Sani, who was ill and hadn't recovered despite being taken to various doctors. We were invited to their home and met Sani, whose hand was bent and couldn't be straightened. We prayed for Sani, and after the prayer, Sani's hand, which was previously bent, could be straightened little by little. Pak Nasirin and his wife were amazed and said that Sani's hand had never been straightened like that before. Sani looked happy and straightened his hand repeatedly. We told them that they could pray to Jesus in their hearts, and if they believed, God would help.

Although one of Sani's siblings said it was just a coincidence, we were convinced that the power of Jesus Christ was real in Sani's life and Pak Nasirin's family. We continued to pray that God would continue to touch Sani's hand and heal it further. May the power of Jesus Christ continue to be evident in that area, and may Pak Nasirin's family come to believe in and worship God.

Prayer Point :

Pray for the N* family to be won over, that through the miracle of their child's healing, they may become open and believe in the power of Jesus.

Pray that through this family, a new house church can be formed. Pray that through this platform of eye checks and provision of reading glasses, many people can hear the Gospel.

Pray that the village head will have the opportunity to hear the Gospel and believe at the next meeting.
