Mission News Headlines

Nigeria (MNN) — On Tuesday (*February 2nd*), radical Muslim militants attacked two villages in western Nigeria and killed at least 162 people. It is the deadliest Islamist attack Nigeria has seen in several months.

Last week Thursday (*February 5th*), Boko Haram fighters also struck a town in northern Nigeria and killed at least 25 people.

Iran (MNN) — Supreme Leader Ayatollah Khamenei said over the weekend that a United States attack on Iran would result in a regional war. The statement came as the U.S. has strengthened its naval and air forces near Iran after weeks of deadly protests and government crackdown.

Within Iran, the regime's brutal response to protestors seems to have quieted the streets. Yet Edwin Abnous with Heart4Iran says, "The real battle for people's hearts and Iran's future is nowhere near over. The very pain that sparked this — the corruption, the hardship, the oppression — is still there." Iran's government has acknowledged over 3,000 deaths during anti-government protests. However, U.S. human rights activists have confirmed over 6,840 deaths. At the same time, beautiful stories are coming out despite the darkness, says Abnous. Stories of "whole families coming to faith because they have had enough of this regime's empty promises."

end of December. The children were motivated with spiritual teachings from a board member. They heard an encouraging message from Eugene Mudogo who is a mentor and soon to graduate from Machakos University with a BS in Teaching. Eugene

is our first graduate from university! If he can do it, others can do it too regardless of circumstances which at times appear despairing.

Our students have been struggling with shortage of paper supplies, so we were able to give them a ream of paper for next year's schoolwork and they were excited! Many of the orphans come from a place of such poverty that paper is not a provision available or prioritized by their guardians. In addition, the orphans received a warm meal including meat to satiate their tummies in



full. In fact, we had such an abundance and there was enough left over to share with the children surrounding our event hoping for just a small parcel of food left over. We were happy to share!

I personally find this work of God such a wonder. What a joy that He has called us to be a part of it. This community (village) has taken on the mantle of doing God's work and we were not even there with a mission's team to motivate them. God motivated them. Every little detail of beautiful things God does through out this village is simply amazing. My heart is longing to encourage each of you to just sit with God, maybe with your favorite coffee, tea or lemonade, and just ponder the beauty of Him. The glory of our precious God that we are privileged to know. Be still and know that He is God.
