Mission News Headlines

Iranian evangelicals are staying put, tentative but hopeful, says pastor

March 3rd, 2026

Hormoz Shariat preaches to a congregation of millions of Iranian Christians around the world, who have scattered because of repression at home. He also preaches to those who, having stayed, have long been the target of arrest by Iranian authorities.

In an interview with media on Sunday, Shariat said since the news that Ayatollah Khamenei had been killed in a strike Saturday, plans for escape and emigration are being put on hold. Many hope that a brighter future may be dawning.

"This is a day of rejoicing and hope for the people of Iran, who have suffered for so long over the years," Shariat said. "With this death of the supreme leader, everybody is firstly happy and hopeful, but are still asking, 'What's next? Is this the end of the regime or not?' That's the big question right now for everybody."

Amani Fellowship

March 2026

Greetings to all our Amani Fellowship partners and prayer warriors. I am excited to share that **we were able to provide a total of 67 pounds of maize seeds to our widows on February 28th!** The raining season in Kenya has begun so the timing is perfect and the widows will work hard planting their crops by hand. We now wait on the mercy of God to provide a tremendous harvest!

This year God did not provide a mission's team for Kenya. He has been gentling giving me the impression to slow down and be refreshed this year after experiencing a challenging season last year. I was planning to travel a few days to Pakistan on my way to Kenya to build greater partnership with some local ground pastors (a different outreach program). I put that on hold, which is good because Pakistan and Afghanistan just went into full war on February 27th. I proceeded with my ticket to Kenya for March 24th thru April 28th, making it only a 5-week missions' trip. The plans include a full day event at Kwirenya Primary/Secondary School with both our students and local villagers. Pastor Steve estimates up to 400 children attending. We have proceeded to organize an outreach with a local non-denominational evangelical team to partner with us for a worship and teaching. Augustine, Kenya Board Member, has begun to organize a soccer scrimmage after our worship service. For those less inclined to soccer we are organizing a Christian movie presentation. With my additional time there, I will work closely with our new accountant and visit numerous children at their homes to get a clear understanding of their living conditions and needs. Further, I will be assessing the potential purchase of property for farming to help sustain our program. Unfortunately, with the onset of war on February 28th, Iran retaliated with air-strikes against United Arab Emirates, hitting

tourist hotels near the airport. My flight itinerary to Kenya lands into Dubai with a one night lay over. At this moment, all flights to Dubai International Airport are suspended. So, I may not even be able to make my flight to Kenya. I will be discussing tentative alternative plans with our Kenya Board Members. Please pray that I am sensitive to the voice of God and use wisdom in the days to come regarding this mission's trip. Pray for God's Word to be active and alive as He describes in Is 30:21 'Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," Whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.' I am so grateful for each of you lifting up prayers on this matter.

Greetings from Brazil!

I have some exciting updates since I last wrote. About a week ago I **finally received my residency identity card**. It's usually a 1-2 month wait time, but for me... it ended up being a 6 month wait. Brazil often runs on it's own timeline and all you can do is patiently wait. With this identity card, I can now open a bank account here and work towards getting my official drivers license. This will help a lot with transferring money internationally between bank accounts and also in continuing to drive here. Foreigners can use the drivers license from their home country for a time, but that time is running out for me. So it's perfect timing that I received this card so I can be more settled here for the long run!



When I was back in the USA this last summer, I shared about a project to help a family in need. The family is a single mom with 4 kids ranging from 18 years to 9 months. The goal is to fix up the house she built haphazardly when she left her abusive husband so that she can rent it out and receive some income. She is now renting an apartment that is a bit bigger and in a better area of the community. I have great news that the **project has finally began**. There were some delays with rainy weather and in finding a trustworthy contractor, but praise God we are now moving forward. With the gifts of New Harvest and another church in Idaho, I've been able to purchase the roofing material and the cost of the contractor.

The first phase is to replace the roof that leaks a lot. We are increasing the pitch and the overhang of the eaves so the rain runs off much better. The first step in this phase was to deliver the material to the worksite. The building material company couldn't deliver directly to the house so it was all delivered to my house (**pic 1**) and from there we used our little ministry truck to arrive closer to the house (**pic 2**). From the street near the house we descended some crazy stairs (**pic 3**) and wound through the alleys to finally arrive at the house (**pic 4**). Just getting the material to the house was a full day project.



Prayer Requests:

Continued wisdom and movement in this building project. Also, for Joice (the mom) to have spiritual growth, good planning for the future and finding employment. We're helping with a big need, but she also needs help in learning how to take initiative and be consistent day to day.

Perseverance and joy for me. I've hit that point where I miss home. I'm still firm in my calling to be here in Brazil, but at times I feel sad and overwhelmed and want to return to the US to be with family, friends, and all things familiar.

Thank you New Harvest for your prayers and support as I'm serving God in Brazil. Your care truly helps me feel encouraged to continue in the work. --Marie
