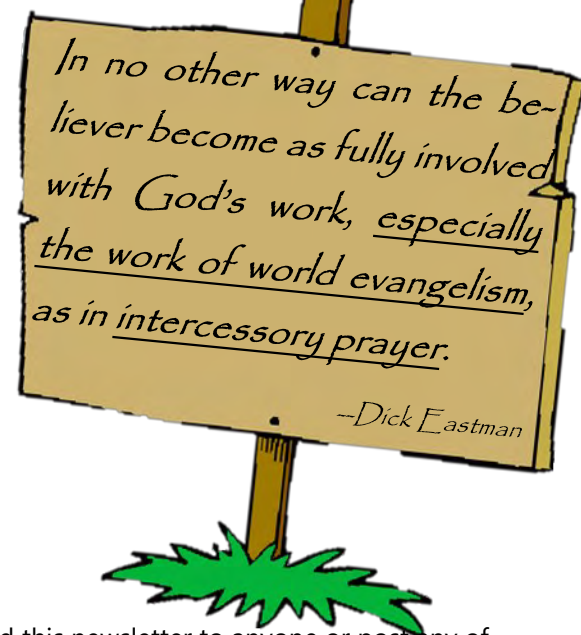

Pastoral Insights by Pastor Barry

I recently finished a study on the letters of Peter and was reminded again about the significance of

2 Peter 3:9, "***The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.***" This verse says so much about our God and what he cares about most. He wants everyone to come to Him and find life, right!

The next sentence in Peter's letter tells us that the Day of the Lord will come unexpectedly. This is obviously referring to Christ's second

coming when both the justice of God will bring retribution and rescue, at the same time. Those who did not receive the life offered through Jesus will be separated and experience punishment forever. The annual celebration for Amani Fellowship in Kenya on April 11th was a beautiful success! Most of our students in AF gathered along with students from Kwirenya Primary/Secondary School and local village children. The day kicked off with 2 intercessory sessions (prayer and worship) each followed by a brief sermon provided by two different church outreaches (Victory Fellowship International and Shiloh Everlasting Grace Outreach). Five students performed spiritual scripts and songs along with a speech of appreciation to all the sponsors in the US. Specific thanks were given for identifying children in need, sponsoring them in education and exposing them to a spiritual life.

Our students were provided with schools supplies such as exercise books and writing pens/pencils. They were thrilled with the quality and quantity of such provisions which they often lack. The Kenya AF Board Members encouraged our students to seek and serve God foremost, focusing on spiritual growth and service, academic success, character develop-

ment and avoiding behaviors that hinder what is best for them to succeed in all areas of life. There was an open opportunity to all who desired to meet individually with our board members for individual prayer and guidance.

We presented a film on the life of Jesus to share more of the beautiful news of salvation by our Redeemer. Next, a soccer game, comprised of AF Students and Kwirenya Students, brought a large crowd of excitement. Our team lost by one point but played to their best, both teams enjoying the competition between each other. Lastly, everyone was served a large plate of spiced chips (potatoes) with tomatoes and plenty of soda and water. A special treat together, wrapping up a day to be remembered by all.

I pray that somehow, each of you can grasp the joy and unique day provided to these youth. With our God and the partnership of those here and in Kenya, a great blessing was showered down on this village in Kenya!

Greetings from Brazil!

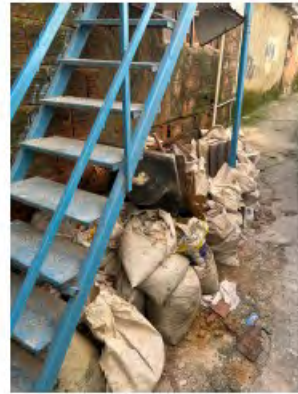
Happy Spring from Brazil!
