How Well Is It Going?

8.16.20

1. **Deuteronomy.6:2** “. . . so that you, your children and their children may fear the Lord your God.”
2. **“Fear the Lord by keeping his commands.**
3. **Deuteronomy 6:3** “So that it may go well with you.”
4. **God’s goal is a good outcome.** Even though God allows difficulty and crisis to unfold, His goodness is poised to intervene.
5. **Deuteronomy 12:8**
Where, “everyone is doing as they see fit” = deterioration
6. **Isaiah 29:13** Worship based on rules leads to hearts that are far from God.
7. **Deuteronomy 5:29**
The Christian’s goal is to develop and nurture a heart inclined to honor God and love others.

Discussion Questions:

1. Why do we tend to focus more on the rules than earnestly seeking God through prayer, reading and meditation?
2. What does the phrase “so it will go well with you” tell us about God’s heart and desire?
3. Describe the effects of focusing on the rules and/or how others are not following the rules versus a person earnestly developing a heart that is inclined to honor God and love others.
