The Bible: It All Begins With God's Revelation

This is our launch to the summer sermon series. We believe if we don't have a firm foundation, it is hard to be stable. The first topic is presented as of first importance.

II Timothy 3:10-17

The Apostle Paul presents a drastic <u>comparison</u> in chapter 3. Psalm1 does the same: What is the key to spiritual prosperity? <u>Delight in and meditate on Gods revelation</u>

First — "God-breathed" = <u>Revelation</u>

The Word of God is living and active." -Hebrews 4:12

Il Peter 1:20-21

"The Bible is inerrant as originally given, verbally inspired by God and a complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men and women."

Second — "Useful/Profitable" = Inspiration

The <u>reception</u> of divine truth

"a time to tear down and a time to build up"

The Word of God is a <u>double-edged</u> sword. -Hebrews 4:12

Tear down = <u>rebuke</u> & <u>correct</u>

Build up = teach & train

Third — "Equipped" = <u>Transformation</u> Romans 12:12, "by the <u>renewing</u> of your mind" John 17:7, "Your <u>Word</u> is truth"

This will not happen apart from <u>God's Word</u>!

Reflective Questions

- 1) If you had to describe the importance of the Bible, what might you say?
- 2) The Apostle Paul suggests that God's Word is so significant that it has the power to keep you on the right path. How does this happen practically?
- 3) How high is your view of God's Word? What does that inspire you to do?
