 - ✓ We owe the <u>Scriptures</u> to Him.
 - ✓ He continues to convict . . .
- * He is in you

Ezekiel 36:25-27 & Joel 2:28-32

- √ Jesus = <u>resurrection</u>; Spirit = <u>Pentacost</u>
- ✓ John 16:7 tells us this is better.
- √ He empowers us to <u>speak</u> & <u>serve</u> (I Peter 4:10-11)
- √ We don't need more of Him; he needs more of us

II Corinthians 3:17-18

The fellowship of the Holy Spirit gives <u>freedom</u> and produces <u>transformation</u>

Too often we <u>miss</u> the abundant life because we <u>miss</u> the key ingredient.
