After three Sundays on the inspiring truth about God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we step down for a look at mankind. The life of mankind is continually affected by sin.

### Genesis 3:1-19

#### The Nature of Sin

- Source, • Susceptible, • Self

“There is a way that seems right to a person, but its end is the way of death.” Proverbs 14:12

#### The Consequence of Sin

- \* “Fig leaves/hid” Fear/Shame  
From Genesis 2:25 to 3:7 . . . cover up
- \* “The woman you put here . . .” Self-Preservation/Blame  
From Genesis 2:23 to 3:12 . . . everyone for themselves
- \* “The man is united with his wife . . .” Relational Tension/Game  
From Genesis 2:24 to 3:16 . . . competition
- \* “Painful birth/painful toil” Pain/Same  
From Genesis 1:30 to 3:17 . . . life is difficult
- \* “To dust you will return” Mortality/Flame  
From Genesis 2:9 to 3:19 . . . become fertilizer
- \* “The Lord God banished . . .” Separation/Lame  
From Genesis 2:7 to 3:23 . . . brokenness & frustration
- \* “He will crush your head” Redemption/Name  
The promise of Genesis 3:15
