"outward demonstration of inward faith"

- "cut to the heart" conviction
 "realized their need"
- "repent" <u>change</u> of mind
 "forgiveness through Jesus"
- "gift" the <u>promise</u> of the Holy Spirit
 "newness of life"

Communion = Sustaining Grace

✓ Apostle's teaching; ✓ the fellowship; ✓ prayer and . . .
 ✓ the <u>breaking</u> of <u>bread</u>

The Purpose:

- Confession sin and surrender
- Conflict resolve and reconcile
- Church <u>community</u> and <u>come</u> <u>together</u>

VBS = vanishing believer syndrome

Begin well = <u>Baptism</u>; Continue well = <u>Communion!</u>
